Becoming Wabi Sabi

Explaining Wabi Sabi ...

Wabi Sabi represents a comprehensive Japanese world view or aesthetic centered on the acceptance of transience.

Wabi Sabi is a philosophy; it is a way of life. Wabi Sabi is closely associated to Zen Buddhism and exemplifies many of its philosophical core tenets.

Wabi Sabi is rarely applied and created; it happens naturally. It is a process that happens over time and is unique.

Wabi Sabi is a personal philosophy; it is a style of aesthetics, the beauty in imperfection. It is the expression of beauty that lies between the mortality and life of ourselves and the objects that are around us. It is the fine line separating something of beauty from something shabby. It is anti-aesthetic. Perhaps it is just another definition of rustic, only it has been given more reverence.

Wabi Sabi is underplayed and modest. It is the kind of quiet, undeclared beauty that waits patiently to be discovered. It's a fragmentary glimpse; a richly mellow beauty that's striking but not obvious.

Dragon Pearl Reiki

The luminous ball or pearl often depicted under the dragon's chin or seen to be spinning in the air, pursued by one or two dragons is thought to be a symbolic representation of the 'sacred pearl' of wisdom or yang energy.

Pearl symbolism, like lunar symbolism arises from Daoist roots and the connections, are extremely complex. This pearl can be said to stand most often for 'truth' and 'life' - perhaps even everlasting life which is made available to those who perceive the truth and attain enlightenment.

The dragon's pearl can also be thought of as a symbol for universal Ki the progenitor of all energy and creation. The dragons seem to be depicted in attitudes of pursuit. He

is seen to be reaching out eagerly to clutch at the elusive object, mouth open in anticipation and eyes bulging with anticipation of achieving the prize afforded by clutching the pearl.

Golden Dragon Pearl

Golden Pearl, transcends the duality of the subconscious and the conscious, the sun and the moon are forming a single energy, the golden pearl. Activates and harmonizes the energy in the first and second chakra, foot contact with the earth and hips energy. It balances the inner core that sits the heart chakra and soul and ascend from the throat chakra to crown chakra with golden energy pervading everything. Activates the earth kundalini. There is a golden chamber around the physical heart, this is the golden dragon pearl. It activates your inner and outer divinity.

There is a place in your heart where sits the spiritual heart. Tune in and integrates the jewel of the dragon with the heart of Mother Earth and the cosmos.

Kukai Mikio wu wei Lingqi

KŪKAI - 空海 -also known as Kōbōdaishi - 弘法大師 - was a tantric master who established the Vajrayana teachings in Japan in the early 9th century.

Kūkai's name combines two elements. Firstly Kū (空 which in Sanskrit is ākāśa and means space, or emptiness (in the sense of śūnyata). Kūkai had a strong association with the Bodhisattva Ākāśagarbha, known in Japanese as Kokūzo.

Secondly Kai (海;) means sea and perhaps relates to the story recounted by Oliver Statler in Japanese Pilgrimage that Kūkai gained Enlightenment on the coast at Cape Muroto, on Shikoku Island. So 'Kūkai' might be translated as Sea & Sky. Sea of consciousness and sky of infinity space.

MIKIO-means tree, in this case tree of unity, beyond duality. MIKIO REFERS TO TANTRIC PRACTICE of the union of heavens and earth deeply rooted in your body, heart and mind.

LINGQI-靈氣- means the spiritual energy of the mountains. It is Consistent, solid energy and everlasting and indestructible.

Wu Wei- is a Daoist (Taoist) belief, which speaks to the idea of letting nature take its course.

It opens and connects the new light frequencies of heavens and lines of the now changing mother earth. Similar to cosmic meridians and earth meridians but in an no duality form.

Fusion Reiki

Dr. Jason Storm, of the Reiki Revolution, received the Fusion Reiki symbol and instructions for its use. He received along with that the name "Fusion."

Fusion Reiki is a mixture of energies of Usui Reiki, Karuna, Seichim and Tao Tian An Mian Chi Gong. The symbol itself is self-attuning, so its power and use lies in drawing the symbol.

Drawing of a symbol can be physically done on paper, visually in your mind, or using your finger/hand drawing it in the air. This means that it is also very powerful when meditated upon.

What is its purpose?

Fusion Reiki greatly amplify and develops your High Sense Perception. It is easy to use by simply drawing it on a client whether in person or at a distance by visualizing the person and visualizing drawing the symbol on them just as you would with other energy systems.

Mindfulness Reiki Do

The attunement will assist on an energetic level to help break down habitual negative thought patterns, Allowing a new awareness of the old, and attraction to the new. Regular meditation and use of Reiki will increase and reaffirm this new awareness and self-care attitude.

Let every use of Reiki, whether receiving, self-treating or attuning be a reminder and rededication That You will use Reiki energy to reveal your hidden patterns to you, energize new positive patterns, and infused new healthy self-management patterns with happiness, fulfilment and joy.

Shi Zen - FREE

Shi Zen is a system that uses the Universal life-force energy to channel the healing vibrations available in nature. It can be used together with Reiki to enhance Reiki treatments or as a healing system on its own.

If you like working with aromatherapy or crystals, you can bring through the vibrations of appropriate essential oils or crystals as part of a treatment using Shi Zen. You can do the same with Bach Flower Remedies and other flower essences. If you like working with Native American Indian Medicine, you can bring through the healing vibrations of animals. Other elements of nature can also be applied in the same way, for example, the vibrations of sunlight and moonlight.

It is not necessary to have the physical items (e.g. crystals or essential oils) in order to work with their healing vibrations. Shi Zen will manifest the vibrations of whatever you request, in an energy form that you will be able to channel through your hands.

Taokan Reiki – FREE

Taokan Reiki™ is a generic name that refers to a growing number of practices using the reiki energy with the Karuna symbols. The following practices and descriptions are one possible manifestation. There are many others that have developed. This art was developed from practices with Karuna and the Karuna Symbols. It could be said that any Reiki is Karuna in that in doing Reiki we are trying to alleviate the suffering of all sentient beings. Taokan Karuna™ is a focus way of practicing this. Taokan Karuna™ is the Way of Compassionate Energy and a Healing and Meditative practice using the Taokan Karuna™ energy and symbols to be the Divine Heart of Compassion.

Tao Reiki Do – Taoist Reiki

Pre-requisite Reiki Master Level

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The history of Taoism or "Daoism" is complex and fascinating.

Often tribal shamans would do battle with each other and there is some historical evidence to suggest early shamanic tribal leaders. In Taoism there is a Particular emphasis on alchemical processes. Although there is indeed a literal desire to change base metals into gold, this is more from the perspective of spiritual and magical healing than desire for wealth. It was believed That drinking from an alchemically created gold vessel would have a similar effect to the Holy Grail cup legend - bring immortality and health. As western white occult practices there is Also the emphasis on personal transformation spiritually. It should be Noted However That Taoism does have a strong tradition of seeking immortality through herbalism, alchemy, magic, Qi Gung and other practices.

Another way in cui Taoism Assimilated shamanic practices is in it's veneration of animal spirits and other spiritual entities. There is an acceptance of the existence of a multitude of spiritual entities Which are Considered sometimes demons, or powers, or even manifestations of prophets or Buddhas. It Should be Noted That Taoism Generally coexists with Buddhism, and in Japan: Zen. Animal spirits or totems are Particularly venerated. Dragons in Particular are Considered manifestations not only of magic, but of powerful evil essence. Tigers are powerful Considered manifestations of female essence. Other animals like the water buffalo are respected Also, indeed Lao Tze is Often portrayed riding one. In Taoism Therefore we have a rich and diverse range of practices: - Shamanism including spirits and animal totems - Magic including casting and spells - Alchemy, both spiritual and physical - Qi Gung and other breathing exercises and martial art - Herbalism and the use of plant extracts Generally - Healing and energy work Later another great work - the I Ching was to become a major Force Within Taoism. The I Ching is Generally viewed in it's popular use, as a tool for divining the future and Gaining wisdom. indeed it is truly an excellent tool for exactly that.

The Svabavikakaya Attunement

Energy is occurring on three levels: the outer, the inner & the secret. These three levels of practice have similarities to what in Daoist practice are known as the Three Treasures (Jing, Qi & Shen); and also to what in Buddhist practice are known as the Three Bodies (Tri-Kaya) of the Buddha/Awakened Mind (Nirmanakaya, Sambhogakaya & Dharmakaya).

The outer level of practice is the most superficial (or densely vibrating) level. In qigong, it is called the level of the tendons and is associated ~ in terms of the Three Treasures ~ with Jing/essence (which, among its physical substances, includes cerebral-spinal fluid, marrow & sexual fluids). This is the level at which one focuses on physical alignment: on creating a structure (of bones, muscles, organs, tendons) conducive to entrance into the deeper levels of the practice. This is the level at which one learns a form which (like a mandala, a yantra, or good or feng shui) can then serve as a portal through which the energies/insights of the inner levels of the practice can more easily flow. So as practitioners, this means learning the particular form(s) associated with Your chosen tradition.

The body of form; the body that is visible to (and which appears in response to the aspirations of ordinary human beings, beings still operating primarily on this outer level.

The inner level of practice is the level of light, sound & color: of vibration that is actually experienced as moving/fluid (vs. the experience of solidity that is characteristic of the outer level), this is the level of the meridians and is associated. This is the level of the pranic body/bodies. It is at this level that one begins to work with the internal forms or energetic. Most illnesses manifest in the physical body from the etheric so he is here to help us with etheric body healing as well.

THESE ATTUNEMENTS ARE called, in Sanskrit, the svabavikakaya ATTUNEMENTS which means the essential body (or manifestation) of enlightened consciousness.

Svabavikakaya ATTUNEMENTS ARE THE UNITY OF INNER AND OUTER AND undisclosed ENERGY.

Three Pure Ones Reiki

The Three Pure Ones also translated as the Three Pure Pellucid Ones, the Three Pristine Ones, the Three Divine Teachers, the Three Clarities, or the Three Purities is the Taoist Trinity, the three highest Gods in the Taoist pantheon. They are sometimes compared to the Christian concept of a triune God due to the roles played by each of them (the Creator, the Guardian, and the Teacher).

The first pure one is universal or heavenly chi. The second pure one is human plane chi and third pure one is earth chi. Heavenly chi includes the chi or energy of all the planets, stars and constellations as well as the energy of god (the force of creation and universal love). Human plane chi is the energy that exists on the surface of our planet and sustains human life and the earth force includes all of the forces inside the planet as well as the five elemental forces.
